Any time you put into preparation for your presentation will count as volunteer hours, with a maximum of 2 submissions per month, counting towards high school community involvement requirements.

Duties/Responsibilities:

Do you know a great, easy, healthy recipe you want to share with others? Do you have a talent for painting or sculpting and a passion for helping others learn? Do you know the latest TikTok dances and want to hold an instructional session? Any other ideas you want to share? YOU present the program and we'll share it on our social media.

- Create a video that can be shared via social media
- Videos should be no more than 10 minutes long
- Videos should contain original content, created by you and not copied from someone else
- The steps you took to create the video and how long this took needs to be documented in order to count towards volunteer hours.

Content is submitted via email to stirlingrawdonlibrary@gmail.com and then we curate the content to be shared. Any writing is expected to have proper spelling, be grammatically correct and not contain any profane language. Any videos, art or music are expected to be appropriate for all audiences.
