

Virtual Producer

Summary:

This is a virtual volunteer opportunity that you can do from home. Virtual Producers create music playlists for books in order for library materials to be shared with library patrons to create connections between students and library patrons, as well as promote the library collection.

Volunteers will be given 1 hour per playlist for their submission/participation, with a maximum of 3 playlists per book, counting towards high school community involvement requirements. Create playlists for as many books as you like.

Duties/Responsibilities:

Virtual Producers are required to create a 10 song (or more) playlist for a book. Only 3 playlists can be created per book but you can write playlists for as many books as you would like.

- Books should be part of the library collection, either in print or OverDrive or accessible through interlibrary loan
- You can choose a book, eBook, audiobook, manga or graphic novel.
- Playlists should contain at least 10 songs and can be created on Spotify or as a list
- Find songs that “feel” like the book or reflects the theme or time and place of the book
- Playlists should be created by you and not copied from anyone else.

Content is submitted via email to stirlingrawdonlibrary@gmail.com and then we curate the content to be shared. Any writing is expected to have proper spelling, be grammatically correct and not contain any profane language. Any videos are expected to be appropriate for all audiences.

- You are conscientious, reliable and independent
- You demonstrate strong communication skills, verbal and written
- You are open to learning new skills and undertaking new opportunities
