

## **Leapfrog Tablets**






These will be replacing our outdated Early Literacy Stations and will be made available for use within the library. Stay tuned for more information on when these will be available for use!











### Did you know... Interlibrary Loan

If we don't have it at the Stirling-Rawdon Public Library we can try to get it for you!

Through interlibrary loan we can obtain books, audiobooks and microfilm from other libraries throughout Ontario. DVDs are not available for interlibrary loan.

All library materials requested through interlibrary loan are subject to the availability and loan policies of the lending libraries. You need a valid Stirling-Rawdon Public Library card to make an interlibrary loan request.



Before submitting an interlibrary loan request make sure to check the library catalogue first. If we have a copy of the title that you are looking for we will not send out an interlibrary loan request, unless you are requesting it in a format we do not have such as large print or audiobook.

To submit a request simply ask library staff! We will ask for the title and author and your contact information. You will then be contacted when we receive the item you requested.

There are times that we are not able to fill an interlibrary loan request, for example, if an item is obscure, or too new. Libraries like to keep their new items for their library patrons and many libraries will not ship out anything that has been published in the last year.

If you are wanting a specific title that has been published in the last year, that we do not have, consider putting in a purchase request instead. We love getting suggestions for new titles to add to the library collection!

# How long does it take?

The length of time to receive an interlibrary loan depends on where the item is coming from. When we submit a request it doesn't mean that a specific library will be able to fill that request.

If an item is out on loan or missing or damaged it is not able to be shipped out. The request will then go on to another library and so on until the request is filled or it reaches the end of the rota.

All items are shipped through Canada Post. Most items will come within 1-2 weeks but sometimes it can take up to 6 weeks to receive a specific item if it took a while to fill the request or if it is coming from the other end of the province.

Most items can be renewed if you need a longer due date but granting a renewal is dependent on the lending library and a renewal cannot be guaranteed.
