## Did you know... Printing Services

If you need something printed, photocopied or faxed, the library is the place to go! Before coming to the library ensure you have the things you want printed, copied or faxed or are able to access them from a computer and staff are happy to help if you need any assistance.



We can also scan documents to an email or flashdrive. There is no charge for scanning.



### How do I print, photocopy or fax?

To fax: Simply bring in the documents you want to fax along with the fax number and we will do it for you. Faxes are \$1 a page. Cash only.

To photocopy: Bring in the pages you want to photocopy. Either photocopy them yourself or ask staff for assistance. Photocopies are \$0.25 a page per side for black and white and \$0.50 for colour. Cash only.

To print: Use one of our computers to access documents on a usb stick, from your email or by typing something in Word or another program. Prints are \$0.25 a page per side for black and white and \$0.50 for colour. Cash only.
