Board members volunteer their time and serve for 4 years, concurrent with the Township of Stirling-Rawdon. Board members should be passionate about the library and their community, and willing to advocate on behalf of the Library. Members should also have an open mind, good communication skills, and willing to work as a member of a team committed to community service.

Cardboard Creations. Using the provided supplies we'll use our imaginations to make something amazing!

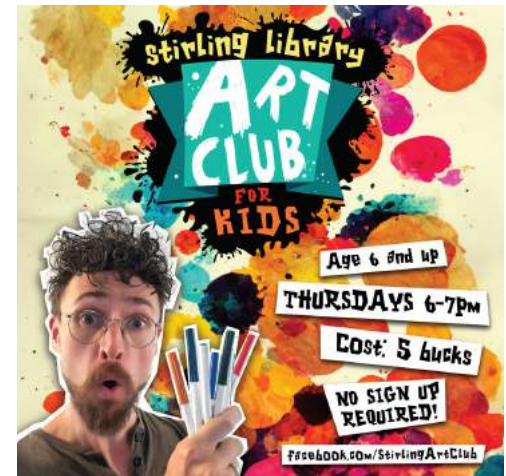
September 21st: Games Club

The Good Baby Box can be ordered for September as usual.

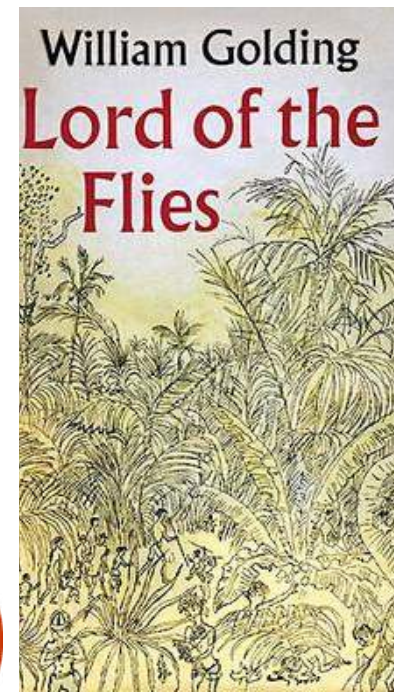
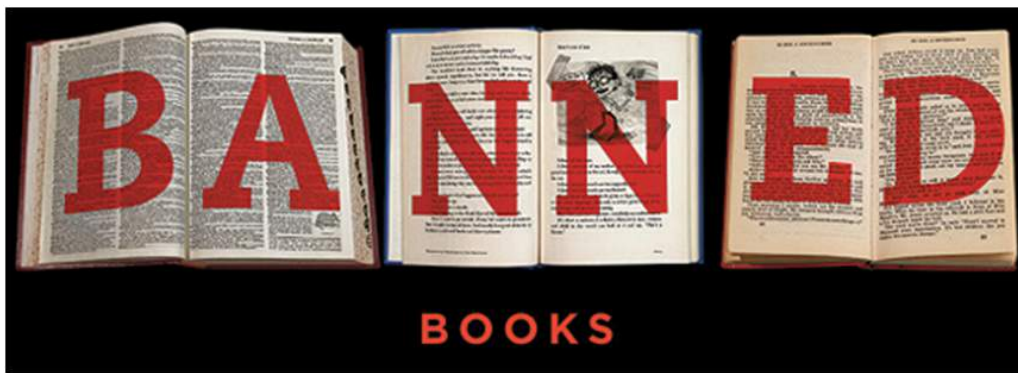
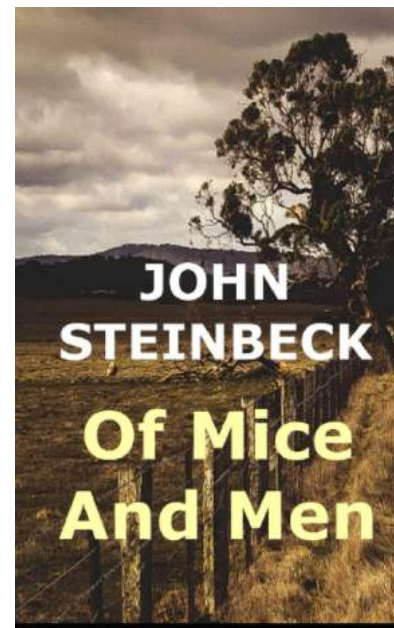
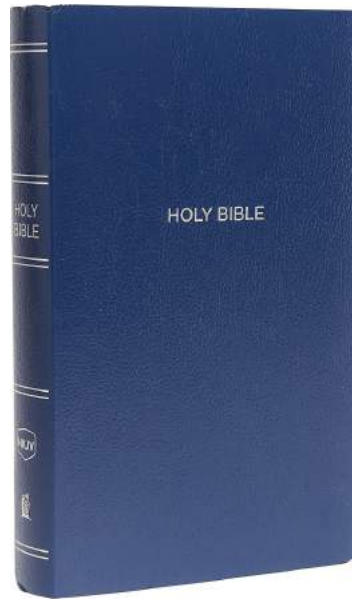
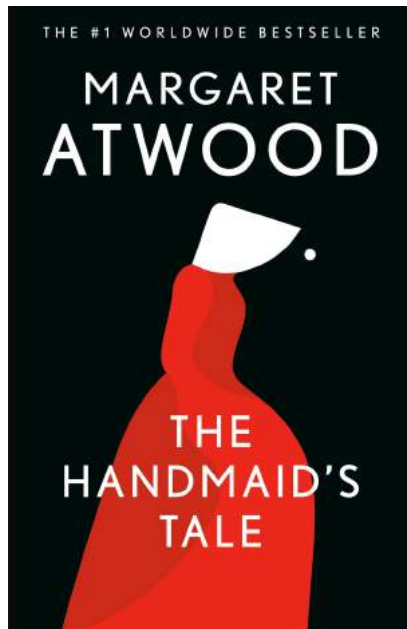
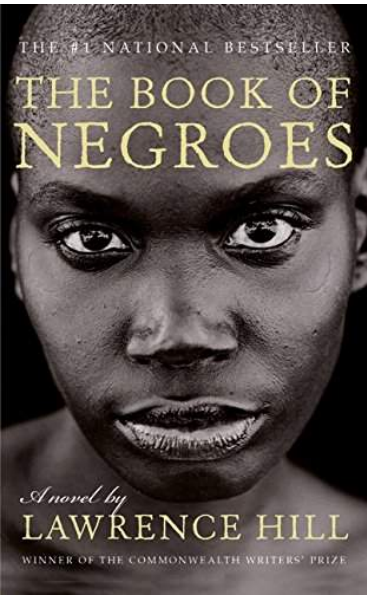

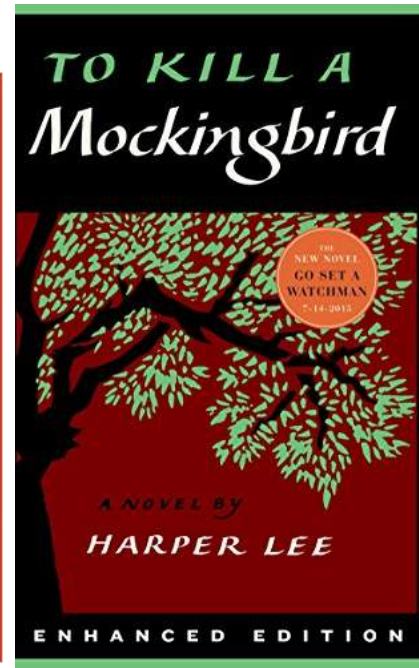
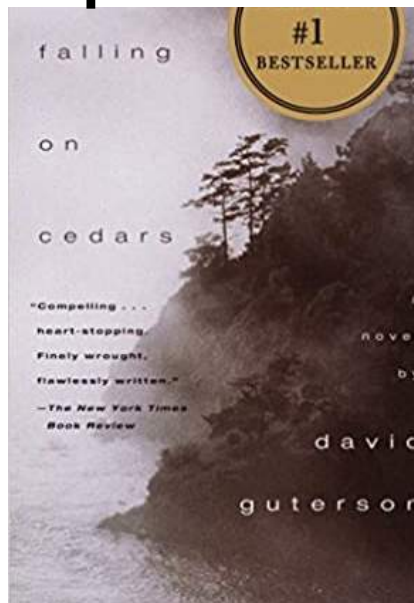
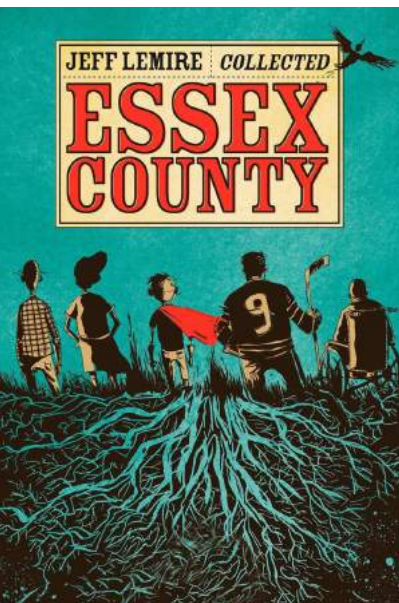
In the children's department
