Since we moved to a new book distributer in the fourth quarter of 2023, patrons should notice that the inventory of new books will be consistently added to our collection in 2024 and new releases should be more readily available to our patrons.

Fundraising efforts and the generosity of our patrons made 2023 one of the most successful years we've had for donations. With these funds, we hope to be able to offer some enhanced programming for children and adults, continued improvements in the Art Gallery, more comfortable seating for time spent within the library, new collections for borrowing purposes and more.
