### **Library Update**

#### **New DVD Pool**

We are excited to have joined the Southern Ontario Library Service DVD Pool! The pool consists of a rotating collection of 80 DVDs that will be replaced every three months and includes both children's and adult entertainment and educational titles.

#### **Stirling-Rawdon Past & Present:**

Please note that our local history site, Stirling-Rawdon Past & Present which is hosted by OurDigitalWorld, has been down since February 25 and will remain offline until they have issues resolved. At this point, no timelines have been provided for the return of services. In the meantime, our physical local history collection is always available for reference purposes and is now located in the Adult Department of the library. Please feel free to browse this collection whenever the library is open.

#### **Overdrive:**

After April 15, users with devices running Android OS 7.1.0 or earlier will be required to update their operating system or switch to another supported device to continue using OverDrive services since their web certificate provider is discontinuing support for those operating systems. Starting the week of March 25, impacted Libby users will see a message to update their OS or switch to another supported device to continue using the app. This message will include steps for how to use a setup code to easily copy their library cards, loans, holds, and tags to another device. In honour of Earth Day, we are pleased to feature a display by Our Part NatureCo. in our lobby display case through the month of April.


























## In the art Callery March 2nd - May 3rd
