



The Envoy Connect is the world's first accessible, solar-powered, compact, portable, durable, audiobook player. Easy to use with a tactile keypad makes this audio player ideal for blind and low vision users.

To borrow the device, simply get in touch with library staff with your request of titles, authors or genres and we will load up to twelve books from the Centre for Equitable Library Access (CELA) website onto the device on your behalf! We'll let you know when the Envoy Connect is ready for you to pick up and enjoy.
